Whether administered as a fellowship or as an assistantship, it also provides tuition coverage and a medical insurance supplement. The Graduate School allocates funding to the academic programs which select fellowship recipients based on the established guidelines.

<sup>3</sup>These are recruitment awards. Identification of possible recipients usually occurs during the admissions process, utilizing materials in the admissions application.

<p><b>George Washington Carver</b> Awarded annually to doctoral-seeking students from Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Hispanic-serving institutions, or Tribal colleges, who have demonstrated superior academic achievements and scholarly abilities. Recipients must be admitted for Fall 2009 or Spring 2010 and aspire to a career as a professor in higher education.</p>	<p><b>\$20,000/year</b> 5 years Graduate School support</p>	<p><i>Announcement</i> November 2008</p> <p><i>Deadline</i> <b>January 27, 2009</b></p> <p><i>Award Notification</i> March 2009</p>
<p><b>Charles C. Chappelle</b> Provides a one-year fellowship to students with undergraduate degrees from Purdue for the furtherance of post-graduate research at Purdue University. Recipients are selected on the basis of character, intellectual ability, and promise of degree attainment. It provides a stipend, Graduate Tuition Scholarships, payment of most fees, and a medical insurance supplement.</p>	<p><b>\$18,000/year minimum</b> 1 year Graduate School support</p>	<p><i>Announcement</i> November 2008</p> <p><i>Deadline</i> <b>January 30, 2009</b></p> <p><i>Award Notification</i> March 2009</p>
<p><b>David M. Knox<sup>1</sup></b> Awarded to masters-seeking students to enhance the diversity of the graduate student body through the recruitment of students with diverse backgrounds, views and experiences. The Knox Fellowship commits a two-year award package to the fellows. Tuition and fee coverage and a medical insurance supplement are also provided.</p>	<p><b>\$18,000/year minimum</b> 1 year Graduate School support; 1 year of graduate program support</p>	<p><i>Announcement</i> November 2008</p> <p><i>Deadline</i> <b>January 30, 2009</b></p> <p><i>Award Notification</i> March 2009</p>
<p><b>Ludwig Kruhe</b> Established as a "means for promoting a deeper interest in world problems, to the end that a better understanding of international relationships and world affairs may be advanced." It provides one year of support, including a stipend, payment of tuition and fees, and a medical insurance supplement. Recipients are doctoral candidates in one of the following Purdue graduate programs: Agricultural Economics, Civil Engineering, Foreign Languages and Literature, History, Management, or Political Science.</p>	<p><b>\$15,750/year</b> 1 year Graduate School support</p>	<p><i>Announcement</i> November 2008</p> <p><i>Deadline</i> <b>February 4, 2009</b></p> <p><i>Award Notification</i> March 2009</p>
<p><b>Bilsland Strategic Initiatives</b> Provides an opportunity for graduate students, under the direction of a faculty member, to impact graduate education by addressing a Graduate School strategic initiative. Individual graduate students may submit a proposal for one award related to any of the Graduate School strategic initiatives.
